What's in the Box;

1 x Bluetooth Earphones with Cord Winder 1 x Charging Cable 1 x User Manual 2 x Gel Earbuds (both in L and S sizes)

The earphones are designed to clip onto your clothing. Pull the earphones without applying excessive force and extend the cord. The length can be adjusted by pressing the rewind button on the top.




- 1. Rewind Button

Cord Winder

Earphones cord can be extended by gently pulling the cord. The cord can be rewound (shortened) by pressing the Rewind Button.

Macaron Mini 2 is designed to clip onto your clothing.

Charging Your Earphones

In order to fully charge the battery before you start using Macaron Mini 2 Bluetooth Earphones, please connect one end of the charging cable to a USB power source (e.g. Computer) and the other end to the micro USB charging port of the earphones.

Status	Status Indicator
1. Charging	Red light illuminates
2. Full Battery	Off
3. Low battery	Red light flashes every 5 seconds
4. Empty battery	Off

· Only use the supplied charging cable to charge the device.

· Fully recharge the battery every 6 months in order to prolong the battery life.

 If the earphones have not been used for a long time, it will take some time for the charge indicator to appear.

Operation

Switching the Earphones On and Off:

A. Switching On

Press the Multifunction Button (MFB) and hold until status indicator turns blue.

B. Switching Off

Press the Multifunction Button (MFB) and hold until status indicator turns red.

Initial Pairing with Mobile Phone

1. When you switch your earphones on for the first time, they will automatically switch to pairing mode and the blue light will remain illuminated.

2. Make your Bluetooth® function of your phone visible to all Bluetooth®-enabled devices nearby.

3. Select "ttec Macaron Mini 2" on your phone's screen and press "OK" to connect to the earphones.

4. When pairing is done, the status indicator of the earphones will go off.

Pairing the Earphones with a Bluetooth®-enabled Mobile Phone

- 1. Enable the Bluetooth® function of your mobile phone.
- 2. Make sure the earphones are switched off.

3. To activate the earphones' pairing mode press the Multifunction Button (MFB) and hold until the blue light remains illuminated.

4. Run a search for the earphones, select "ttec Macaron Mini 2" and enter "0000" as the password. A password is not necessary if your mobile phone supports the "Easy Pairing" function.

5. When pairing is complete the blue light will go off.

Pairing the Earphones with Two Bluetooth®-enabled Mobile Phones (Multi-Point)

Pair your earphones with the first mobile phone (follow the steps in "Pairing your Earphones with Bluetooth-enabled Mobile Phone").

2. Switch off the earphones and Bluetooth function of the first paired phone.

 Pair your earphones with the second mobile phone (follow the steps in "Pairing your Earphones with Bluetooth-enabled Mobile Phone").

Activate Bluetooth connection with the earphones and the first paired phone from the phone menu.

Some phones may need to be connected to the earphones by pressing the "Connect" button.

 If pairing is not completed in two minutes, the earphones will automatically switch to standby mode and switch off after three minutes. Repeat the steps to reconnect both devices.

Reconnecting Your Earphones and Listening to Music with the Earphones

 If the earphones switch off, they will automatically reconnect to the phone after switching on.

2. If the phone is switched off and the earphones are disconnected, you will need to reconnect the earphones by using the Bluetooth menu when the phone is switched on again. Otherwise, the earphones will switch off.

Listening to Music with the Earphones

You can listen to and control music through your phone. However, if a call comes in music is paused for you to answer the call.

Music play resumes when the call ends.

 The ttec Macaron Mini 2 is designed for mobile phones with a Bluetooth Hands-Free profile (or for a Bluetooth device). Since some phones have different operating systems it is not guaranteed that all of the features will function.

In order to receive better and clearer signals during calls, make sure there isn't anything obstructing the path between the earphones and your phone.

Troubleshooting

I cannot adjust the volume on my earphones.

- Please adjust the volume from your mobile phone.

I cannot connect to my mobile phone.

- Please make sure your earphones are switched on and fully charged.
- Please make sure your mobile phone's Bluetooth feature is enabled.
- Please make sure the earphones are in pairing mode (blue light illuminates)
- Please make sure your earphones are within your mobile phone's range.
- Please make sure your phone is visible to all Bluetooth devices nearby (when the earphones are in easy pairing mode).
- Please wait for a few seconds when searching for Bluetooth devices.

If the above steps do not solve the problem, please switch the earphones off, recharge them and try again.

I cannot hear audio from my earphones.

- Please make sure your earphones are switched on and fully charged.
- Please make sure your earphones are paired with and connected to your mobile phone.
- Please make sure the call has not been transferred to your phone.
- Please make sure the volume is sufficiently high.

I cannot switch the earphones off.

Please press and hold down the MFB button for a few moments. Otherwise, charge your earphones for 2-3 seconds and disconnect the charger. Your earphones will now switch off.

I cannot switch the earphones on.

Please make sure your earphones are switched on and fully charged; otherwise, charge your earphones for 1-1.5 hours and switch them on again.

I hear a warning tone from the earphones during the call.

Low battery warning, please charge your earphones.

I hear a noise during the call.

There may be an obstacle between your earphones and mobile phone. Please remove this obstacle or put your phone on a table rather than holding it with your hands.

Safety Precautions

 If you accidentally apply excessive force to the rewind button the earphones cord rewind pullback may be damaged.

2. Please be careful when rewinding the earphones cord. Maintain a safe distance between your face and the earphones. 3. If you must use the earphones when driving, please focus all your attention on your driving. Act as a responsible driver and obey local laws.

4. Please store out of children's reach and never let children play with the earphones. Children may swallow small parts.

5. Observe these rules in certain places where electrical devices must be switched off such as hospitals, electrically limiting and hazardous areas.

6. Switch your earphones off before boarding a plane. Do not use your earphones after the flight attendant has instructed you not to do so.

7. Never put or store your earphones in the deployment zone of airbags; otherwise serious injuries may occur when the airbag is deployed.

8. As they don't have any repairable parts, please do not attempt to open your earphones.

9. The earphones have internal batteries. Therefore, dispose of the earphones in accordance with local regulations and do not treat them as domestic waste.

Maintenance

Your device is the result of sophisticated design and masterful craftsmanship thus, its maintenance must be carried out with special care. The following recommendations will help you preserve your warranty coverage.

· Please store all accessories and attachments out of children's reach.

- Please keep the device dry. Rain, moisture, and all kinds of liquids contain minerals that may be corrosive to electronic circuits. If your device gets wet please dry it thoroughly.
